ECU BREAKS GROUND AND CUTS RIBBON IN ONE DAY



Thursday, February 6th, was a momentous day for Eastman Credit Union and its members. ECU staff broke ground for a new branch and support center on the West Loop and cut a ceremonial ribbon for their Mortgage Lending Center, located at The Crossings at Main and Main, during a celebration at the Hilton Garden Inn.

“Over the years, I’ve visited Longview many times. Visiting our branches, I’ve watched this community flourish and our membership grow. This is an exciting day for ECU and a very exciting day for me as well,” said Kelly Price, president and CEO of Eastman Credit Union.

Longview residents, business leaders, and local officials gathered with ECU representatives on the 5-acre West Loop 281 site near Pine Tree Junior High School, which will open in the Spring of 2021.



“We are pleased to announce that this almost 34,000 square foot facility will offer a full-service branch on the first floor, and the second and third stories will offer space for additional local support staff to assist our branches and the growing membership in East Texas,” said Price.

ECU also celebrated the recent Mortgage Lending Center that opened on Nealy Way in the new development adjacent to Loop 281 and Highway 259. The Mortgage Lending Center spans over 4,200 square feet and will also accommodate additional staff during the construction of the new branch and support center.
